IMAGINEMKE | ARTIST RELIEF FUND RESULTS

ON MARCH 13, Imagine MKE launched the MKE Artist Relief Fund in response to the COVID-19 crisis. Each week, applicants were invited to submit for that week's cohort by Wednesday evening.


All working artists that resided in Milwaukee County and could provide proof of practice were approved for relief, a total of 423 artists.


Applications were peer-reviewed by a rotating team which included **23** total reviewers.


Order of fund distribution was determined by 1.) affiliation with a traditionally marginalized group, and 2.) time of application. Aligning with the organization's value of equity, priority groups were identified of: Black / Indigenous / People of Color, transgender & nonbinary, and/or artists with disabilities.

208 applicants cited affiliation with these groups.




